Any student who does not support our school Behaviour code and acts in an inappropriate manner, which undermines the safety and learning environment in our school, or acts in a way that show no respect for themselves and others, will not be eligible to participate in the above activities for that school term,

In Particular:

- 1. Suspension or Exclusion
- 2. Persistent absence or late arrival at school
- 3. Consistent disruptive behaviour in class
- 4. Failure to make a genuine effort in class
- 5. Consistently unacceptable choices being made during play times.
