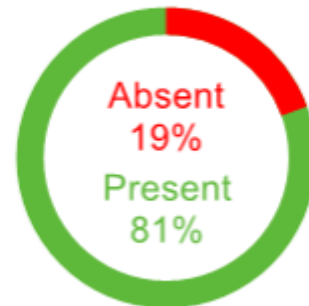

VOLUNTEERS
