



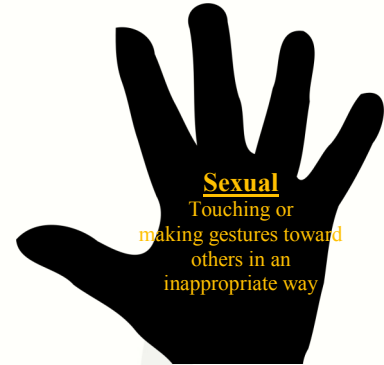
Anti Bullying Policy

Bullying and Harassment

Bullying and harassment is behaviour that targets another student or teacher due to their identity, religion, race, gender, and physical characteristics and disability.

Bullying is used with the intent to cause fear, distress or harm to another student or teacher. Bullying can be verbal physical, direct indirect.

Bullying is NOT

Conflict or fights between equal persons or a one off single incident.

Violence

Violence is the intentional use of physical force or power, threatened or actual violence against another person. This may constitute assault, which is a police matter.
