Inclement Weather

General Information

Staff and students may find a change in routines at recess or lunch times due to weather conditions on the day, to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all staff and students on site.

Staff and Students may be required to spend recess and lunch indoors when it is raining, strong winds, cold unpleasant weather or extreme heat.

On mornings of catastrophic weather conditions, the principal will be onsite in the morning to make sure that no students or staff are on the school grounds. Once they have cleared the site the principal must leave as well due to safety reasons.

Parents/Caregivers have the responsibility to listen to warnings on the morning of catastrophic conditions.

<u>Rain:</u>

If it starts raining at recess or lunch for anything more the a passing shower, all students are to return to class and the duty teacher must let the front office know it is raining and to ring the rain bell. All teacher must return to their classrooms immediately.

Each class teacher resumes responsibility for the students in their classroom. Students should not leave their classroom during this time. Should the rain stop students may return to the yard with the yard duty teacher for the remanding of recess or lunch.

<u>Hot Weather</u>

On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday the library will be opened up during lunch from 12:55 till 1:20. Students can go and spend time in the airconditioned library. The days that the library is open there will be a staff member who will be rostered on for the library.

Hats

In terms 1 and 4 all students are to remember to bring their school hats (caps are not acceptable) to school so they can play out in the sun. If a student forgets their hat they will have to play up in the shade on the verandas. <u>NO HAT, NO PLAY</u>
Staff are also expected to wear hats and lead by example to the students. Hats and be purchased from the front office.

Extreme Heat

On day when the temperature is predicted to be 40 degrees or more at lunch time, student and teachers will remain in the classroom. If the students or teachers go out in this heat it presents potential health hazards

It is not practical for all the students to be crammed into the library, this is why they are asked to remain in their own classroom.
