Congratulations to Dillon who made the 100m and 200m finals.

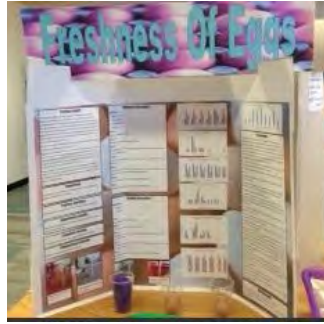
We would also like to thank all the parents who assisted on the day either by transporting the students to and from Loxton, timekeeping and supporting the students.
