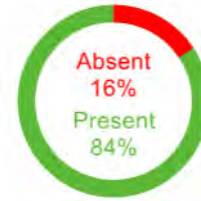

At the last Governing Council Meeting there was a discussion about the changes to Year 7 students attending High School. The Department has recently released information about the change.

"South Australian Year 7 public school students will be taught in High School from term 1, 2022. This move will bring South Australia in line with other jurisdictions."

This directive means that our current Year 3 students will be required to attend High School in term 1, 2022 as Year 7s, and the current year 4 students will complete Year 7 at Primary School.
