## **2019 Materials & Services Charge**

*Under Guidelines from Department for Education a verified copy of **Glossop Primary School's Materials and Services charge for 2019 is listed below.***

In line with these procedures, parents (if they wish) are invited to discuss the composition of this charge with the Principal or the Governing Council Chairperson. Our 2019 fees for Glossop Primary School are below the standard sum that can be charged, as determined by Department for Education for primary students in South Australia for 2019. Our fees for 2019 will remain the same as this year and are \$220.

Each family will be invoiced in January 2019. School Card application forms will be available early in the new year. If you were eligible in 2018 you will receive a 2019 School Card application with your invoice, to complete if you believe you will be eligible. Thank you. **Glossop Primary School PRESCHOOL FEES will remain the same for 2019 — \$30 per term - invoices to be sent out in January 2019.**
