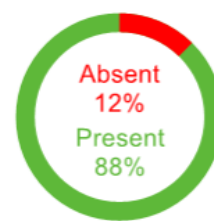

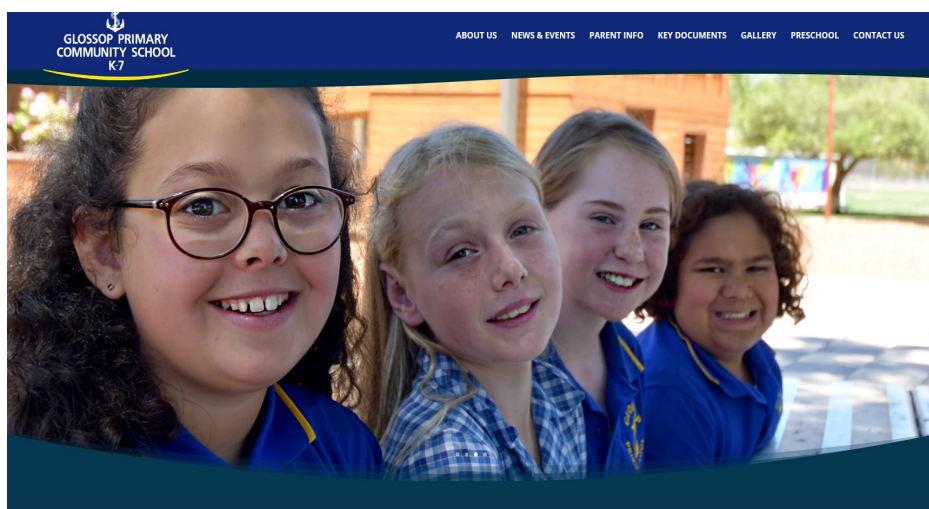

IMPROVEMENT PLANNING 2019

During this term our site has worked on developing the Improvement Priorities for 2019. This has involved an in depth gathering of evidence on how our students are learning and what as a site we need to focus on to ensure learning improvement for all our students.

To do this our first step has been to analyse evidence of students learning and answer the question 'What are our goals for improvement?' We then determined our challenge of practice. Teachers make the biggest difference in student progress in learning, and our improvement is focused on how improvements in teaching practice will help us achieve our goal for improvement.

Our improvement goals for 2019 are:

- Increase student achievement in reading Preschool to Year 7, both achieving South Australian reading standard and higher band achievement.
- Increase student achievement in mathematics—particularly in number Preschool to Year 7 both achieving South Australian numeracy standard and higher band achievement.
- Increase oral language achievement across all curriculum areas Preschool to Year 7.

This planning will ensure our improvement focuses are aligned with our budget and ready to commence from day 1, 2019.
